		Threatening	A Patriot, detailing what the Loyalists (Tories) deserve after the War	As a punishment for the Loyalists, to scare Loyalists, to urge others to take action against the Loyalists
		Mocking	A British citizen, mocking his King and government	To make fun of the King, to make a statement about the weakness of England, to express frustration about the outcome of the War.
		Angry	A Loyalist, angry with his own country (America)	To express anger about the outcomeof the War. To express loyalty to the King, and chastise his fellow Americans to change their ways and realize the error of their ways.
		Violent	A Patriot, warning Loyalists what will happen to them since they betrayed their countrymen.	To strike fear into the hearts of the Loyalists and threaten retribution by Patriots and/or Natives.
