4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Shows comprehensive understanding of ideas and vocabulary presented in text; synthesizes information.</li><li>• Includes significant amount of details from answers to questions on Podcast Guide, along with many additional details from text.</li><li>• Uses student's own words, with interesting sentence structure and word choice.</li><li>• Shows logical organization of ideas, with usage of an appropriate text structure.</li></ul>
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Shows understanding of information and vocabulary presented in text.</li><li>• Includes many details from answers to questions on Podcast Guide; many include a few additional details from text.</li><li>• Uses student's own words.</li><li>• Shows logical organization of ideas.</li></ul>
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Shows limited understanding of vocabulary and information presented in text.</li><li>• Includes few details from answers to questions on Podcast Guide; may include details from student's brain that are not mentioned in text.</li><li>• Uses some of student's own words; may rely on vocabulary from text or make use of some phrases from primary text.</li><li>• Shows some attempt at organization; may have details out of logical order or randomly listed.</li></ul>
1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Shows erroneous understanding of vocabulary and information presented in text.</li><li>• Includes little or no details from answers to questions on Podcast Guide; may include details unrelated to topic of text.</li><li>• Relies on phrases or sentences copied exactly from primary text.</li><li>• Lacks organization and is difficult to follow.</li></ul>
